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SOME NOTES REGARDING INTRODUCING AND CONCLUDING READINGS

1. When the service is from the BAS, please introduce the reading by simply saying:

“A reading from ...” (do not include chapter or verse numbers)

Examples: *“A reading from the Book of Numbers”*; *“A reading from the Second Book of Kings”*

Please pause briefly at the end of the reading, and then say, **“The Word of the Lord.”**

2. When the service is from the BCP, please introduce the reading by saying:

“The Lesson is written in the ... chapter of ... beginning at the ... verse.”

Example:

*“The Lesson is written in the fourth chapter
of the Book of the Prophet Isaiah,
beginning at the first verse.”*

Please pause briefly at the end of the reading, and then say, **“Here endeth the Lesson.”**
